

DBWGC General Meeting Minutes – June 6, 2017

Captain Barbara Mensch called the meeting to order at 1:55 p.m. A quorum was present with 31 attendees.

Approval of Minutes from General Meeting of March 14, 2016. Shelly Morgan made the motion to approve the Minutes, and Jan Baehr seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report. Barbara Mensch presented the March 2017 Treasurer's Report. She noted that it shows more Invitational money coming in, but she encouraged early payments as well. Kathy Readler moved to approve the Treasurer's Report, and Becky Frazier seconded the motion. The budget was approved.

Invitational Update – Joanne Leete. There are currently 112 signed up. Joanne is wanting 128. The Tee prizes for 128 have been purchased and the food is based on 128. Only one is signed up from the Breakers. Checks are due July 1.

Susan Leeper asked if since we're committed to 128, will the price increase? Joanne had no plans to increase the price. Joanne is considering trying to get more from the Breakers or even going to Trilogy or Brentwood to solicit more players.

2018 Go Red Tournament - Becky Frazier. This year's Go Red tournament will be on October 24. There will be raffle prizes, a silent auction.
