Call to Order – Captain Sondi Schnee

There were 21 attendees.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Treasurer's Report – Notes from Doris Bunnell

- Membership dues – we now have 57 members since Patty Uyeno rejoined.
- GHIN Dues of \$39 per member have now been paid.
- We agree with the February Bank Statement.
- Excluding the \$400 to be donated to Liberty, we have almost \$2000 for all other expenses throughout 2021.

There were no questions about the budget and the budget was approved.

2. Tournament – Cindy Renshaw

Spring Handicap is April 6 & 13: Discussion about changing dates as some would be unable to play. Changing dates next to impossible due to other activities in April and general limitations (Covid).
